Gail welcomed members and called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m.

Financials: Shelley has updated the branch financials through September 30, 2024. AAUW will file the branch tax returns, and Shelley will ensure that they are filed. Shelley presented the proposed 2024-2025 budget and the actual budget. Discussion occurred regarding how Elaine will know who has paid their dues; she will check on the AAUW hub and also call Shelley if necessary. The branch insurance cost is high, and Gail will write a letter to the state board asking for a reduction since the branch only meets online. The current cost of the insurance is \$540.00.

Shelley then explained the proposed budget. The convention line was removed as there are no in person conventions at the present time. The branch has \$500.00 at the Tech Trek Virtual camp, and \$100.00 in the branch Tech Trek account. The branch will participate in Tech Trek again this year.

MOTION: Randa moved to accept the proposed 2024-2025 budget. Motion seconded by Cathy and carried. Shelley will send it to the webmaster for posting.

Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI): Cathy reported that the group met on October 7th. The discussion was about hate groups throughout the United States. There were nine attendees including three from Oregon.

Speech Trek: There are \$800.00 grants available for branches who want to participate in Speech Trek.

Program: Cathy announced that the October 22nd program will be regarding Project 2025.Randa sent out a notice to multiple branches. There are currently eighty people registered, including members of

the Washington On-Line, Oregon On-Line, and North Carolina On-Line branches. The program for February (tentatively February 8) will feature Penelope the Poet, a former Tech Trekker. Whatever money left over from Speech Trek, with approval from the donor, will be given to Tech Trek for a workshop with a speech component. Penelope will teach the workshop.

Membership: Randa will remind new and prospective members of the branch Meet and Greet on Saturday, October 12th at 2 p.m. Elaine appreciates that people are sending her names of prospective members, and she is reaching out to them.
